# Lets get started - The ales...

## **Windermere Pale** 3.5% Hawkshead Brewery - Cumbria **PALE GOLD**

A highly refreshing, very pale ale, bursting with hop character and a fine fruity aroma. Brewed with soft Lakeland water, Maris Otter malted barley and full flower hops - blending three traditional English hops and the modern American hop, Citra.

*Awards: 2017 - SIBA NW Gold Overall Champion of the Cask Competition; SIBA NW Gold, Cask Standard Bitters & Pale Ales; CAMRA Champion Beer of the North West. 2016 - Champion Bottled Beer Silver SIBA NW; Gold SIBA NW, Bottle Standard Bitters & Pale Ales. 2014 - SIBA National Champion Silver Bottled Bitters 2013 - SIBA NW Champion Bottled Beer; 2 Star Great Taste Award. 2012 - SIBA National Champion Standard Bitters Silver*

## **Auld Hemp** 3.8% High House Farm - Northumberland **AMBER**

The first beer brewed at High House Farm, a fine amber coloured traditional bitter with a fresh malty aroma. A true session beer that delivers a highly rewarding drink. This - "The Original" High House Farm beer - has a unique and unmistakable flavour all of its own.

*Awards: 2009 Great British Beer Festival Finalist.*

## **Liquid Sunshine** 3.9% St Austell Brewery - Cornwall **GOLDEN**

*This ale can be found on tap in the bar.*

A perfect taste for the summer!... with hints of zesty citrus grapefruit and orange with a good balance of malt. This beer has plenty of hops about it for a full citrus flavour that blossoms on the tongue, with a fine dry backbone finish for a hugely balanced and drinkable beer. Malts: Maris Otter Pale Malt. Hops: Nugget, Galaxy, Cascade, Centennial

*Awards: 2016 UK Regional Brewer of the Year.*

## **Choco Orange Mild** 3.6% 1648 Brewery - East Hoathly, East Sussex **DARK**

Brewed combining citrus flavours into a dark beer leaving a light smooth chocolate taste in the mouth. Deliciously moorish!

## **Montgomery** 4.0% Wantsome Brewery - Canterbury, Kent **AMBER**

Named after the SS Richard Montgomery which sank off Sheerness during WW2 whilst full of explosives! A delightful Amber best bitter exploding with citrus aromas and brewed using exclusively American hops.

*Awards: National champion 2017 for Best Bitter and SIBA SE region gold winner 2016 for Best Bitters.*

## **Windsor Knot** 4.0% Windsor & Eton - Windsor, Berks **PALE**

Brewed using a special blend of British hops called Invicta in recognition of Prince Harry's role in creating the Invictus Games, combined with some great American West Coast hops. Using only barley grown locally on the Royal Farms in Windsor with a finishing touch of using champagne yeast. Marrying these ingredients creates a new Pale Ale that is young, fresh and full of character.

*Windsor & Eton Brewery has been granted a Royal Warrant of Appointment as Brewer to Her Majesty the Queen. Windsor & Eton Brewery has won over 60 significant awards and brews bottled beer for the House of Commons!*

## **Young Pretender** 4.0% Isle Of Skye Brewing Co - Isle of Skye **GOLDEN**

Shimmering gold and refreshingly full-flavoured, this is a refreshing golden ale with a dry bitter finish and a light hoppy aroma. Hops, Challenger. Malts, Maris Otter, Medium Crystal and Skye's own yeast.

## **Ceralia** 4.2% Milton Brewery, Waterbeach, Cambridge **BRONZE**

Brand new! A festschrift beer to commemorate the career of Prof MK Jones. Brewed with the "5 grains" of Chinese ritual - Sure to be another great beer from our award winning local brewer!

## **Get Pithed, Orange Fruit Beer** 4.2% Yorkshire Heart - York **GOLDEN/AMBER**

Golden amber beer with a small head, lots of orange juice on the nose, dry malty body with dry-sweet orange notes and earthy maltiness. Produced using the best malts and hops and our very own natural spring which helps give our beers a uniquely Yorkshire flavour!

*Awards: 2017 Bronze SIBA speciality lights beers category. 2015 Silver SIBA award speciality beers.*

## **Hullabaloo** 4.2% Lodden - Dunsden, Oxfordshire **WARM AMBER**

*This ale can be found on tap in the bar.*

A multi-grain nutty and malty red beer with a dry hop finish packed with rich flavour and aroma. English Fuggles impart a dry, herby bitterness which is balanced by the distinctly biscuity flavour of Crystal and Amber malts. Brewed with Barley, Wheat, Oats and Crystal Rye and hopped with Fuggles and Styrian Goldings from Slovenia.

## **Lushingtons** 4.2% Skinners Brewery - Cornwall **GOLDEN**

*This ale can be found on tap in the bar.*

Bursting with fruit, within its bittersweet scent you'll pick up lime and mangoes with a little lychee. Its creamy texture contains a slight strawberry finish. This is a cool, hop-laden pale ale brewed using traditional methods with Cornish water, whole-flower hops and Skinner's unique yeast. Hops: Belma, Citra, Willamette. Malt: Cornish malted barley and wheat.

*Awards: Silver SIBA Best Bitter and Golden Ale category.*

## **Orange Wheat Beer** 4.2% Green Jack Brewery - Lowestoft, Suffolk **GOLDEN**

Brewed with 40% wheat malt and a combination of fresh and dry orange peels. This bright golden ale has a restrained zesty citrus flavour from the hops and the peels, balanced with soft sweetness from the wheat malt.

## **Tiller Pin** 4.2% Wishbone- Keighley, W Yorkshire **GOLDEN**

A hoppy American pale session ale featuring all American hops, Citra, Chinook and Cascade and a tiny little bit of Summit, dry hopped in the fermenter.

## **Rabbie's Porter** 4.3% Ayr Brewing Company - Ayr **DARK**

A champion brew crafted using Challenger and Pioneer hops from the UK with crystal and chocolate malts to produce this robust, full bodied ale. The nose has roast coffee, gingerbread and chocolate. The palate is of currant fruit and molasses becoming creamier towards the long warming finish.

**Jack the Devil** 4.5%  
Cullercoats - Tyne & Wear **MID BROWN**

Delicious and rich mid brown, chestnut coloured ale made from Maris Otter barley and the finest English aromatic hops. Perfect balance of malty nuttiness and a fresh hoppy aroma.

**Papa Jangles Voodoo Stout** 4.5%  
Totally Brewed - Nottingham **DARK**

A dark, rich stout with notes of coffee and raisin.

**Brighton Belle APA** 4.6%  
Hammerpot - Poling, West Sussex **GOLDEN**

Golden to pale amber American Pale Ale with fresh floral hops notes, spicy orange, crisp grapefruit and a hint of caramel.

**She Sells Seashells** 4.7%  
Ramsgate Brewery - Broadstairs, Kent **PALE GOLD**

Light Summer ale with a clean, fresh bitterness and a gorgeous, zesty hop flavour. Brewed in a predominantly enduring Kentish style showcasing local hop varieties, such as Northdown & East Kent Golding. Bitterness: High. Sweetness: Medium.

**Syntaxis** 5.7%  
Milton Brewery, Waterbeach, Cambridge **GOLDEN**

Another brand new brew from our local brewers - a Golden strong ale. Full of punchy hop flavours backed by a delicate biscuity malt character.

**Cook Lane IPA** 5.8%  
Timothy Taylor - Snaith, East Yorkshire **AMBER**

*This ale can be found on tap in the bar.*

Named after the site of Timothy Taylor's first brewery in Keighley, this premium IPA is brewed using aromatic English grown Cascade & Chinook hops, giving a more gentle flavour, it has zesty citrus notes and juicy tropical flavours of mango and lime.

**Blackcurrant Dudda** 4.0%  
Dudda's Tun - Sittingbourne, Kent **Medium/Sweet**

A medium/sweet cider blended with blackcurrant juice. Deep and rich in colour, with the flavour of bursting blackcurrants and apple undertones. A perfect blend of sweetness and soft acidity.

**Celtic Tiger** 4.0%  
Celtic Marches - Herefordshire **Medium**

Crafted and liberally imparted with orange and pineapple. Caribbean sunshine and English countryside combine to provide a refreshing tropical cider. A true Herefordshire Cider made with Herefordshire Cider apples.

**Fruit Bat** 4.0%  
Snails Bank - Herefordshire **Medium/Sweet**

Crisp apple cider blended with strawberry, raspberry and blackcurrant. Made from the best fruit that Herefordshire has to offer, using years of experience to craft ciders that are traditional, without chemicals or additives. We work with nature, not against it and, we think you'll agree, the results speak for themselves.

**Lilley's Mango** 4.0%  
Lilley's - Frome, Somerset **Sweet**

A smooth sophisticated blend of somerset cider and Mango juice resulting in a sweet exotic tropical tasting cider from this award winning producer.

**Maverick - Ginger & Chilli** 4.0%  
Orchard Pig - Somerset **Medium**

A deliciously refreshing cider with a Maverick bite... real West Country Cider apples partnered up with a taste of the exotic. An initial nose into the glass reveals the scrumptious mix of citrus and orchard apple. Sweet ginger and honey layers saddle up to the fruit in the first sip, whilst the sneaky chilli moseys along shortly to set your trotters tingling.

**Pickled Parrot Perry** 4.0%  
Lilley's - Frome, Somerset **Medium**

A traditional Perry that is naturally cloudy and full of flavour with a smooth and well balanced taste.

**Strawberry Fruit Cider** 4.0%  
Thirsty Farmer - Nottinghamshire **Medium**

Golden in colour with a slight red hue and soft fruit aroma, that delivers a delicate sweetness with a hint of strawberry flavour with a hint of zingy apple that works perfectly.

**Cornish Orchards Gold** 4.5%  
Fullers - London **Medium**

A creative blend of cider and dessert apples from the West Country impart this classic cider with body and crispness. Immensely refreshing and light with fruity apple tones and a long-dry finish.

**Merry Monkey Scrumpy** 4.5%  
Lilley's - Frome, Somerset **Medium**

A cloudy Scrumpy style cider made from unfiltered bittersweet apples giving a full, rich appley flavour.

Thatchers - Sandford, Somerset **Medium/Dry**

Crafted from vintage bittersweet apples including Tremlett's, Dabinett and Somerset Redstreak. This is a traditional cider full of flavour and big on personality. Medium dry, this still cider bursts with apple flavours and has a depth of character that only comes from generations of experience.

**Gaspig Goose** 5.8%  
Newtons - Herefordshire **Medium/Sweet**

Produced using traditional craft methods this is an award winning, well balanced, golden craft cider made with organic apples grown to Soil Association standards in Newton Courts orchards.

The Garden Cider Company - Surrey **Medium**

Matured slowly and blended to give a smooth cider which is both light and delicate on the palate. This hand crafted premium cider is produced entirely from local, donated garden apples - each year over 4000 local households donate spare garden fruit in return for a share of the cider made. This process utilises an abundant natural resource and turns it into sustainable, ethical, quality cider. Everyone's a winner!

**FTJ - Filthy Tramp Juice** 6.7%  
Apple Cottage Cider - Baldock, Herts **Sweet**

Crafted from local orchards around Baldock using a variety of apples, there are no chemical additives in our products. Slow fermentation keeps all the natural flavours to this fruity cider, smooth, sweet with plenty of flavour, a popular favourite.
